Call to order:

The meeting was called to order at approximately 7:00 pm:

### DESIGN AND DEVELOPMENT, 13th and U PUD

Ted Featherstone, a representative from JBG gave a presentation about the 13<sup>th</sup> and U PUD. He provided characteristics of the physical plant; he also provided answers to SDCA members' questions:

Start date for construction: NovemberProjected timeframe/limit: 22 months

• Amount of bid: \$150,000

In regard to the BID he stated that they are looking at including as far south as Logan Circle and as far east as 17<sup>th</sup> Street. Concern was expressed that the Community Benefits Package for the PUD is for improvements to the area immediately surrounding the PUD site at 13<sup>th</sup> and U and that diluting the BID funding was in conflict to their commitment.

### **ZONING**

Significant potential impacts of the ZRR were discussed and it was noted that each area has specific changes that will affect them individually that need to be further explored.

#### **UPDATE ON PARKING GARAGE**

Suggestion has been made that we work with other interested parties to prepare a clear document about our specific goals for the Parks and Recreation property that can be used for future discussions. Zoning would have to be changed to pave the way for a 500 space parking garage. It was also suggested that if Logan Circle needs additional parking that they should talk to Whole Foods about adding parking to their building.

### **ABRA**

We are awaiting the results of the Amsterdam Falafel protest hearing. Currently trying to reach an SA with New Town.

The meeting was adjourned at approximately 9:10 pm, with our next meeting set for May 15 at 7:00 pm in the Thurgood Marshall Center.
